 - One year only....It is waived
- KMEA CODA Grants
 - Grants that schools can apply for \$200
- KMEA Clinician Cancellation Policy
 - Currently, KMEA has a no cancellation policy

Old Business

- SW KMEA Fees
 - Clarification of Fees were discussed where HS Instrumental will pay for all completed auditions entered into the computer known as an audition fee.
 - It will be state as:
 - "\$10.00 Audition Fee Pay for all completed auditions using the Festival Scores Invoice."

New Business

- HS Band Audition Process Changes
 - Looking to increase numbers for the HS Band, so a change to encourage more students to participate
 - Change to District Audition to make it more approachable
 - o Jacob Miller presented results from a committee put together this past year
 - Back Story:
 - State KMEA Audition music for Band is overwhelming at times
 Geared for hardcore private lesson taking students
 - Play 2 pieces from the State Audition Music excerpts
 - Third piece is a unison etude, which every instrument plays
 - Where we are at now:
 - Looking to change for Fall 2020
 - Sent out 3 options for change to the committee
 - Best option was:
 - o The Chromatic Scale is still included

- o 2 narrowed-sections from the state sections, but then...
- 1 unison/universal etude
 - New etude on a 4-year rotation?
 - New each year over the 4 years
 - Same etude each year?
 - Chair forms a committee to create it each year?
- State Audition Music excerpts
- This will allow the rehearsal of the universal etude with the whole band, instead of students on their own on every part.
- A Directors' Committee will take this to discussion and we will try to take a vote before Fall 2020...Will try for July, 2020
- Look at eliminating Lunch for the Elementary Concert in January
 - Do we need a fee change?
 - Concert time moved to 12:15pm? Both groups?
 - What if Elementary moved to 12:15pm? MS Remained the same?
 - 12:15pm concert does not provide enough rehearsal time.
 - Jessica Ralston and Claire Thompson will check with other membership and return an answer to the July 2020 meeting.
- Webmaster Fees
 - Presently SWKMEA pays \$1,000 per year
 - Looking to increase to the \$1,500-\$2,000 range from each KMEA district
 - Due to the time requirements on me during the fall semester, which is essentially district honor groups season.
 - In addition to assisting teachers with their NAfME membership and KMEA Members site accounts, the district email groups and honor group systems are maintained on a daily basis during that time-frame.
 - Research will be done by Kelly Knedler and Brandon Wade where results will be presented for a vote in July, 2020 Board Meeting
