TROY JOHNSON

- Changes in Registration- the All State Manager will remain this year, then move into the KMEA Members site.
 - Some districts have the policy of teachers entering students for events at the State and District level require that the teacher must be a member of KMEA in good standing.
 - Festival Scores is a non-KMEA property, so it would be easy for Troy Johnson to change anything we need on the website. Also, would make it easy to check memberships. He is working on all permissions to do so.
 - Troy will be in touch with Brandon when all forms are available.
- O Assistant Chairs/Chairs Elect Please send Troy the names as soon as they are known. He can add them to the email lists. Helps them to become connected.
 - There is no limit to number of recipients to email aliases.

 - State requirements: 1800 x 450 pixels

 - Do not put anything with a caption.
 - We do not want to identify any student by name

 - Announcement only setting: \$2.00 per month per group
 - All group-discussion setting: \$3.00 per group per month
 - There will be an "opt in" form and request form to add your email to any group.

DISTRICT FOCUS AGENDA

- o Bylaws are written and adjustments are being made
 - Would like to see the SW Board adapt to mimic the State Board
 - 4 Chairs would be replaced every year instead of 8 every two years
 - Add Chair-Elects and have them serve as Elect the year prior to their term as Chair.
 - This would help keep consistency from year to year and help train our officers ahead of time.
- o Allowing only directors who are active members of KMEA to register students for the All-District Honor Groups.
- o Increase registration to make up the difference of price for Festival Scores
 - We will re-word "Audition/Participation" Fee as "Registration" Fee and add \$1.00 to the Registration fee for all groups, except HS Choir and Elementary Choir, because they do not use Festival Scores.
 - 2016-2017, SW KMEA took care of all Festival Scores fees for all district events. Those who paid, mainly MS Band, were refunded their Festival Scores fees for "Auditions."
 - The Executive Director will still need to monitor late fees.
 - District Chairpersons will have to "TURN ON" Invoices settings in Festival Scores!
- o Add \$15 fee if school does not send in an invoice with payment.
- o No longer use Pepware for our plaques and shirts but move to Clark Comley, "Precision Engraving" (precisionea.com)
 - The State is no longer using Pepware and has moved to Clark's business. Clark is ready to take on the full business of the State and will have at least one person at each District concert to work the booths.
 - State is strongly urging us to move to this but has left the decision in the District's hands.
- o Jodi Reese requested the page 4-C-1 be updated on the website.
 - Section 8 We will not limit the number of quartets, thus eliminating section 8.
 - Jodi Reese would like to change the Tenor Audition key.
 - Use the same key as the Soprano and Tenor just sings it an octave lower.

VOTING

- Board Member Terms Jodi Reese moved to go to alternate year elections beginning Fall of 2017 for Chairpersons in HS Band, MS Band, MS Orchestra and Elementary Choir along with the other four positions being Chairpersons-Elects voted on Fall of 2017, thus creating a alternating rotation on the SW KMEA Board for the future. HS Choir will need to fulfill a third year term and HS Jazz Band, HS Orchestra and MS Choir will fulfill their normal two year terms. Seconded by Rachel Trombley. Unanimously passed 8-0!
- <u>Membership</u> Jodie Reese moved that we as a district, allow only directors that are active members of KMEA be allowed to register students for district honor ensembles. Seconded by Lynn Unruh. Unanimously passed 8-0!
- Wording Jodi Reese moves to change the wording of "Audition/Participation" fees to "Registration" fee. And all district groups using Festival Scores have \$1.00 added to the current Registration fees. Also, all groups using Festival Scores will be using the Festival Scores Invoices exclusively. Seconded by Sean Boller. Unanimously passed 8-0!
- <u>Invoices</u> Rachel Trombley moved to add a \$15.00 fee if school does not send in an invoice with payment. Seconded by Lynn Unruh. Unanimously passed 8-0!
- <u>T-Shirts/Plaques/Medals</u> Sean Boller moved to abandon PepWear and move to Precision Engraving for all future gear (T-Shirts, Plaques, etc.) at SW KMEA District events and interests. Seconded by Lynn Unruh. Unanimously passed 8-0!
