  - a. Grant Mathews

    - iii. Clarinets are low in numbers, please try to encourage clarinets to audition in the future
    - iv. 21 Flutes (largest group)
    - v. Good Brass
    - vi. Percussion is up this year
    - vii. Audition Process
      - 1. State has not yet released new material yet
        - a. Will probably add some to our process when released
      - 2. Do we still want to get the judging window completed before the first November Saturday?
